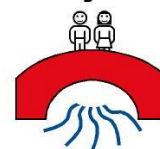

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

Maestros Annual Musical Instrument 'Have a Go' evening Monday 17th July-8pm

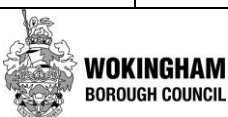
