Parents evening for parents of children in F2-6

Parents evening for parents of children in F2-6 will be held on Tuesday 6th and Wednesday 7th October. Y1-6 teachers will be in the main school hall and F2 teachers will be in the FSU Hall. 10 minute slots can be booked between 4pm and 6.50pm. You can make your booking between Wednesday 30th September and the morning of Monday 5th October.

To book please add your name to the class sign-up sheet or telephone the school office and we will do it for you. If the weather is dry sign-up sheets for Y1-6 children will be in the playground outside the school office before and after school. If the weather is wet the sheets for Y1-6 children will be available in the foyer outside the school office. Sign-up sheets for F2 children will be available in the FSU hall from 30th September until the morning of 5th October.

Pupil Premium

If you are on a low income and receive one of the benefits listed below we can apply for additional funding to help to support your child's educational achievement. If your child qualifies they may also be able to continue receiving free school meals (beyond Year 2).

To qualify for free school meals for your child you must receive one of the following:

- Income support
- Income-based job seeker's allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Child Tax Credit - provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income that does not exceed £16,190
- The guarantee element of the State Pension Credit

If you think your child qualifies for funding, please contact the school office.

Cycling to school

Please ensure if your child is cycling to and from school they have a cycle helmet of the appropriate size for them which is in good condition and are encouraged to wear it. We are always pleased to see children using their bikes to get to school and their safety remains of utmost importance to us.


Bulmershe Family Fun day Sunday 27th September 10am-4pm - Bulmershe School Playing Fields
