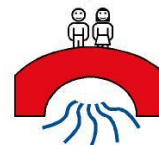

Congratulations to the following children who have received a Values 'House Gem' celebrating their actions in promoting our school values.

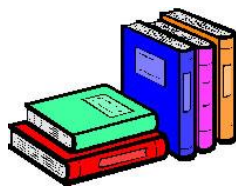
