Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> December 6pm (doors open at 5.50pm). Please, no under 6 year olds in the audience

There will be a retiring collection for lighting and sound equipment for the new hall.

Arrangements for the children

In order for the children to get the full benefit of being a part of the production we do expect that all children will attend all performances. If there are extenuating circumstances for your child not being able to attend any of the performances please let your child's class teacher know as soon as possible.

For the evening performance we would like children to arrive between 5.30 and 5.45pm (No earlier please - the teachers will not be ready!)

They will need to be taken to the doors of the Year 2 corridor where the children will then take themselves to the appropriate place to get changed and ready for the performance. Parents attending the evening performance all need to wait in the hall.

At the end of the performance we will take the children back to the Year 2 classrooms where they will change and then be brought back to the hall - please wait in the hall for your child(ren).

If you are not coming to watch the evening performance yourselves the children will need to be collected at 6.45pm, also from the hall.

Allocation

We can seat a maximum of **two** guests per child performing for the evening performance. The school reserves the right to ask the name of the child you have come to watch if it appears there are more than two people in your party. This will not apply if you are attending the afternoon performance.
