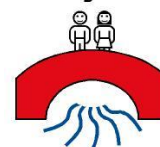

You will need to sign the slip, giving permission for them to attend and tick the relevant box, telling us how they will get home after the club. Please ensure that your request slip is in by the deadline so places can be allocated and clubs can begin on time. All slips should be returned to the school office by **Wednesday 13th January 2015**.

This term, we are giving pupils the opportunity to request a first and second place club. We will endeavour to place all pupils in their first choice club, however if this is not possible then we will use the second choice option.

Please note that where more children wish to take part in a club than there are places available **names will be selected at random from all requests so as to allocate places at the club**. You will be informed on **Friday 15th January** via a slip to your child, if your child has a place. Unfortunately if your child does not receive a slip it means they do not have a place. If there are any spare spaces for any of the clubs we will send out a separate letter and pupils can then sign up at the office. This will be on a first come, first served basis. Pupils are welcome at this point to sign up for a second or even third club, if spaces are available!

Please remember to let the office know in good time if your child is not able to attend their after school club.
