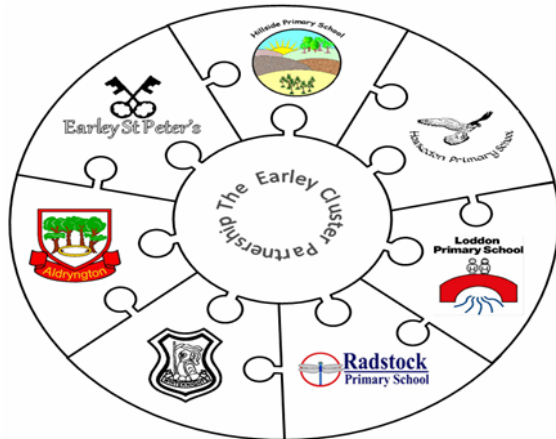


Earley Cluster Partnership

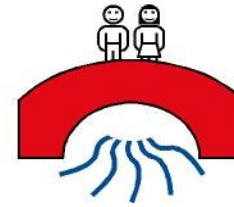
Parent and Carer Workshops

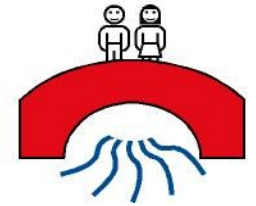
Loddon Primary is part of the Earley Cluster of Schools and parents can attend workshops at a variety of local schools.

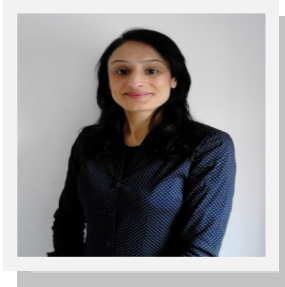

Parent Support Advisors help parents and carers achieve positive outcomes for their children. This may include providing information, organising group events, giving practical help or offering a listening ear.

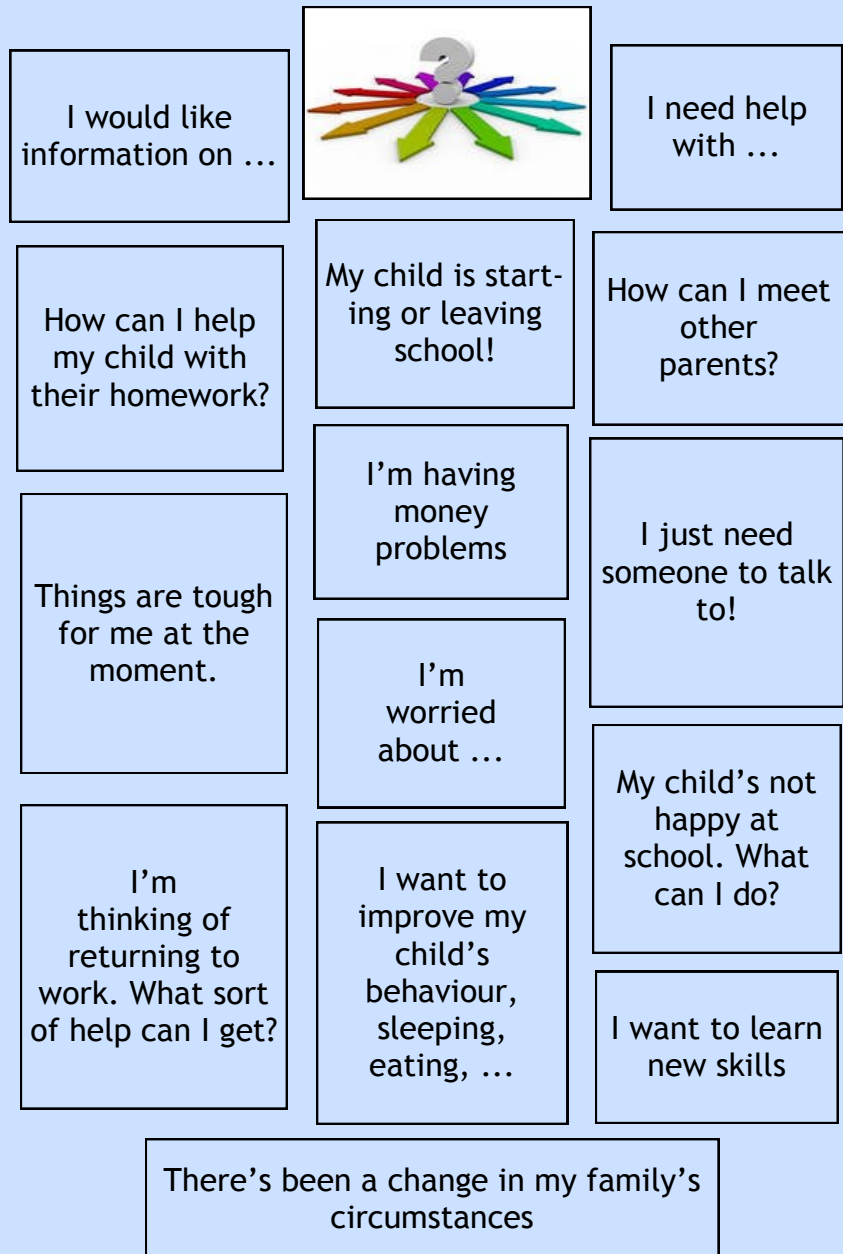
Parent Support Advisors aim to:

How it works....

- You do not need to leave your name but noting down donations & exchanges tells us how much the exchange is used.
