Glossary

PTA: Parents and Teachers Association.

The Loddon PTA is made up of both teachers and parents who volunteer to help raise vital funds for the school through events such as school discos and school fairs. As well as fundraising, the PTA exists to strengthen the relationship between parents and the school

AGM: Annual General Meeting – This is the formal meeting of the association, where the committee members report back to their members about the activities they've run throughout the year, and where the election of the new committee happens. As the name suggests, AGMs are held once a year, which means the timing for future AGM's will mainly be determined by when the last meeting happened.
