Subject: Loddon Primary School Parking

It has come to our attention that vehicles have been seen to be parking inappropriately outside Loddon Primary School. We are writing to you to inform you of the dangers and further actions that may be taken against owners of the vehicles, if they continue to park inappropriately/dangerously.

Yellow zig zag lines are located outside of schools and also found at the entrance or exits of hospitals, fire stations, police stations or ambulance stations and are used to indicate the length of road where you should not wait, stop or park a vehicle. Yellow and white zig zag road markings are placed to show that the area must be kept clear to allow an unrestricted view for approaching drivers and riders or children wanting to cross the road.

These traffic regulations are in place to keep your children safe, and to avoid accidents occurring due to cars parking inappropriately and inconsiderately.

If you are caught stopping on the zig zags, single yellow lines or double yellow lines you will be dealt with accordingly. I would like to make you aware that failure to comply could result in you being issued with a **fixed penalty notice**.
