



Dear Parents/Carers,

Loddon Primary School has the exciting opportunity to take part in the annual WASMA music performance at The Hexagon. The children will be performing in a choir of 400 children with live music, also performed by children. Although the event has an emphasis on singing, there are also opportunities for acting and dancing. Auditions will also be held for some children to sing solos or in small groups.

This year the concert is called 'Curtain Up' and we be singing songs from musicals including: 'When I grow up' from Matilda, 'Any dream will do' from Joseph , 'Tomorrow' from Annie and 'Supercalafragalistic' from Mary Poppins.

The concert will be on Sunday 19 March 2017, with a rehearsal in the early afternoon.

It is very important that children taking part commit to the concert and come to rehearsals. In addition to those held during the school day at Loddon, Tuesdays at 12:15, there will be three additional rehearsals after school at Hawkedon Primary School and Addington School (31st Jan 4-5:30 pm(+auditions), 21st Feb 4-5:30pm and 9th March 4 to 5.45pm)

Please complete the slip at the end of this letter to confirm whether your child will be taking part and that they will attend the rehearsals. As there will be a limit on the number of children taking part, approx. 20, if I have more than 20 replies I will prioritise Year 6 first, then Year 5 and so on, as we intend going again in future years and so younger children will have the opportunity to reapply for places later in their time at Loddon.
